8-WEEK INTENSIVE CHINESE/SUMMER '82 AT DRBU

In the Intensive Chinese/ Summer '82 session, morning language instruction and afternoon drill, at the beginning and intermediate levels, are followed by evening bilingual seminars in Buddhist Studies. Bilingual presentations on Chinese culture, art, literature, philosophy, and the writing of matched couplets in the classical style complete the program. Instruction is provided six and a half days a week for eight weeks.

The University offers a context of contemplative peace which fosters concentration and study. A deep-felt harmony and quiet is maintained both by abstaining from what is detrimental and by engaging in what is wholesome. Tobacco, alcohol, drugs, dancing, and all contentious or improper behavior are completely prohibited on campus. Daily participation in bilingual worship and bowing to foster humility and magnanimity which is required of every student. All meals are vegetarian.
