CHINESE CIVILIZATION

At the 480-acre campus of Dharma Realm Buddhist University in the beautiful Ukiah Valley of Mendocino County, California, summer students will devote themselves to intensive study of Mandarin Chinese. During its regular academic year, Dharma Realm Buddhist University offers a bilingual, bi-cultural English-Mandarin curriculum in Buddhist Studies, Chinese and Translation Studies, Western and Oriental Art, and English as a Second Language. Summer Chinese language students are therefore able to make rapid progress by immersing themselves in an atmosphere where Mandarin is constantly being heard and spoken by both native and non-native speakers.

In the Intensive Chinese/Summer '82 session, morning language instruction and afternoon drill, at the beginning and intermediate levels, are followed by evening bilingual seminars in Buddhist Studies. Bilingual presentations on Chinese culture, art, literature, philosophy, and the writing of matched couplets in the classical style complete the program. Instruction is provided six and a half days a week for eight weeks.

The University offers a context of contemplative peace which fosters concentration and study. A deep-felt harmony and quiet is maintained both by abstaining from what is detrimental and by engaging in what is wholesome. Tobacco, alcohol, drugs, dancing, and all contentious or improper behavior are completely prohibited on campus. Daily participation in bilingual worship and bowing to increase one's humility and veneration are required of every student. All meals are vegetarian.
