

EVAMPRAMUKHĀḤ ŚĀRIPUTRĀDHASTĀYĀM DIŚI GAÑGĀNADĪVĀLUKOPAMĀ BUDDHĀ BHAGAVANTAḤ SVAKASVAKĀNI BUDDHAKṢETRĀŅI JIHVENDRIYEŅA SAMCCHĀDAYITVĀ NIRVEDHANAM KURVANTI. PRATĪYATHA YŪYAMIDA-MACINTYAGUŅAPARIKĪRTANAM SARVABUDDHA-PARIGRAHAM NĀMA DHAR-MAPARYĀYAM. (15)

"With such leaders, Sariputra, in the lower direction of the Buddhas, World Honored Ones, comparable to Ganges River sand, having covered their respective Buddhalands with their tongue, make their penetration: 'All of you, believe and accept this discourse on Dharma which is called one that is praised for its inconceivable qualities and received the protection of all Buddhas.'"

Just the name of the direction has been changed from the text as it appeared before in issues #143, #144 and #145 where it was thoroughly explained.
