tense (present active indicative):

person	number	verb form	& translation
1st	singular	tisthāmi	I stand
2nd	singular	tisthasi	you stand
3rd	singular	tisthati	he/she/it stands
1st	dual	tisthāvas	we (2) stand
2nd	dual	tisthathas	you (2) stand
3rd	dual	tisthatas	they (2) stand
1st	plural	tisthāmas	we stand
2nd	plural	tisthatha	you stand
3rd	plural	tisthanti	they stand
