The City of Ten Thousand Buddhas is a major international Buddhist community set among 488 acres of groves and meadows in the beautiful Mendocino County 110 miles north of San Francisco. The quiet country landscape, mild climate, and clean air of the valley give students an ideal environment for study, spiritual growth, and wholesome friendship.

Classes Offered: art, calligraphy (Chinese and English), ceramics, English (reading, poetry, writing,

and vocabulary building), ESL, Chinese (written and conversation), drama, music and singing, gardening, science projects, martial arts, typewriting, woodworking, virtue and ethics, critical thinking and more. The curriculum reflects a concern for educating the complete person rather than teaching academic skills alone. The school encourages students to strive for academic excellence, to be good people, and to nurture their minds and capabilities. Emphasis is placed on character development,

self-esteem, and a firm ground in practical ethics.
