

Dharma Masters Heng Bin and Heng Chia: Graduates of Weekend College

Recently, Heng Bin and Heng Chia graduated with Bachelor of Arts degrees in Humanities from the "Interdisciplinary Humanities" Program, part of the "Weekend College" course of studies conducted by New College of California, which was held at the Indian Valley College annex in Novato.

The intensive course consists of seminar-format classes. Students are exposed to a wide-range of academic disciplines: social, historical, political, philosophical, psychological, scientific, and economic. Classes include both formal lectures and group discussion, after which students write summaries and critiques. They are required to keep journals and do extensive research on a senior project which they present in class at the end of their senior year.

Heng Bin and Heng Chia, who are teachers at Instilling Goodness Elementary School and Developing Virtue Secondary School at the City of Ten Thousand Buddhas, enrolled in the program due to their deep interest in education. They found the program challenging and rewarding.

Qualified students may go on to receive training in Monastic Administration and teaching in Buddhist schools.
