Instilling Goodness Elementary School Developing Virtue Secondary School

Instilling Goodness and Developing Virtue Schools will be sponsoring a four-week special summer program for children and young adults. The school, located at the City of Ten Thousand Buddhas, an international Buddhist community, is set among 488 acres of groves and meadows, 110 miles north of San Francisco, near Ukiah. The quiet country provides students with an ideal environment for study, spiritual growth and wholesome friendship.

The summer curriculum will emphasize a hands-on approach to learning, including an environmental science fair, the opportunity to write and publish students' own work, drama, art, ceramics, music, singing, gardening, martial arts, Chinese language studies and ethics.

This summer the program will be four weeks long, beginning July 9th and ending August 3rd. Activities will begin at 8:30 a.m. and continue until 2:00 p.m. A vegetarian lunch will be provided. The cost will be \$160.00 for the four-week session. There is an additional \$335.00 room and board fee for those who will be boarding at the school.

As with all programs at Instilling Goodness and Developing Virtue Schools, emphasis is placed on character development, caring about others, self-esteem, and good citizenship. Parents may be interested in attending the special summer program for adults, offered in conjunction with Dharma Realm Buddhist University. The two programs will run concurrently.
