Included in the program are optional cultural activities such as Chinese Calligraphy, Chinese Orchestra, Martial Arts, and Chinese cooking.

A community of predominately native Chinese speakers, the City of Ten Thousand Buddhas provides an ideal environment to learn and practice Chinese while experiencing life in a traditional Buddhist Monastery.
