It was all done to tell a story about a happy kingdom that discovered technology, the social and environmental collapse that followed, and the king's task of leading his people to find a balance between technology and nature.

The girls' division of the city's Developing Virtue high school hosted this year's Cherishing Youth Day, and the senior class gave it the theme "connecting with nature." A narrator told the story, and the students from all grades gave performances to illustrate it.

"We teach our children to cherish life and love animals," said Jin Jr Shi, principal of the girls' division of the city's schools, describing the "Buddha's Little Garden Musical" performance by the girls in first through third grades. The students, dressed as butterflies, bluebirds and other animals, held up letters and sang, "S-I-D-D-H-A-R-T-H-A," spelling and then singing Buddha's name in Sanskrit.

All 220 students from all grades at the city's schools participated in the event, manning booths outside, ushering groups of school children to their seats, giving various orchestral, choral, dance and other performances, preparing and serving a vegetarian lunch to the guests invited to the event, according to Jin Jr Shi.

She said the school and community aims to cherish its youth by "sharing words of wisdom, sharing wise values with them. I would say it's more of a mutual learning; we are also learning from them at the same time."

And that she did, having lots of opportunity to do so with 1,050 students in attendance from all over Mendocino County, most of them in prekindergarten through sixth grade. A high school class from Anderson Valley also attended. "This is our biggest year ever," said Steve Setera, a teacher in the boys' division. "We've never had to split it into two shows before. Usually we get 400 to 500 (attendees)."

To accommodate this year's large audience, the school gave two performances. Visiting pre-K through first graders attended the short program from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. and went back to their schools with provided sack lunches, and the older children saw the long program from 10:30 a.m. to 12:40 p.m.

A high school girl dressed in a cartoonish, hooded dinosaur costume led her classmates in a hip-hop dance as part of the long program's story about returning to nature and finding a balance with technology. She reappeared in the final dance number, which encouraged children to play outdoors. It featured students clad in hooded, cartoon-like lion, penguin, panda, giraffe and other animal costumes, and even featured Pikachu from the popular children's game and cartoon Pokémon, and a pink unicorn.



The students even cleaned up after the event so the school did not have to employ a janitor to do so, according to Jin Jr Shi. "We want them to cherish their blessings," she said. "There is no need for a janitor; they have healthy, able bodies."

節目當中,一位全身恐龍裝打扮的女學生,帶領一群女校學生跳了一段嘻哈舞,呼應這次活動的主題——返璞歸真,尋找自然與科技間的平衡。節目的最後,這位恐龍裝主角再次出現,鼓勵在場的孩子們多到戶外走走,這時舞台出現各種不同的動物:企鵝、獅子、熊貓、長頸鹿,甚至還有孩子最喜歡的神奇寶貝「皮卡丘」,當然這些都是由學生裝扮而成的。

活動結束後的整理工作,幾乎由男女校的學生包辦,沒有雇用任何一名的清潔人員。 近智師說:「學生們都很健康活潑,都能自己動手完成。再者,也藉此機會讓學生懂得 珍惜自己的福報。」
