Returns to Hsiang Shan to Spend New Year's #78

When the Master arrived at P'ing Yang Prefecture, he visited the North and South Cave of the Immortals, as well as the shrine of Emperor Yao, in the south part of the city. He then visited King Kuan's temple in Lu Lin village in P'u Chou Prefecture. Crossing the Yellow River, and travelling on through T'ung Kuan Pass, he went to Hua Yin in Shensi Pro-vince, where he visited the temples on the western peak of the mountain. He saw long banners and deep gorges, and at Lao Chun Li Kou, he gazed at the beautiful scenery. Leaving Shou Yang, he went to Hsiang Shan mountain, where he saw the tomb of King Chuang. From there he proceeded to Kansu, saw K'ung T'ung Mountain, and then returned to Hsiang Shan Mountain to spend New Year's.
