He then went east to HSIANG-HSI and HENG-YANG, where he bowed to the Venerable Master HUNG-CHIH. Then he went to PAO-TUNG (Jeweled penetration) Temple in HU-PEI and bowed to the Abbot CHIH-MO, and remained there until the Dharma Assembly of the Great Compassion Repentance ended. Proceeding on to LU-SHAN Mountain in CHIU-CHIANG, he paid his respects to the high Master CHIH-SHAN, (Good will) and at HAI-HUI Monastery, he took part in a Buddha Recitation Dharma Assembly.
